## Students who attend Purdue Polytechnic High School will:

- » spend time each morning setting goals and discussing current events with their teachers (we call this advisory time)
- » experience fewer class periods to allow for more in-depth exploration of subjects
- » learn by connecting their subjects to real-world challenges and projects
- » focus on science, technology, engineering and math (STEM), especially during their first two years
- » connect their knowledge and skills to possible careers through internships and industry certifications
- » prepare for a future that includes a college education (such as Purdue University) or a high-tech career.

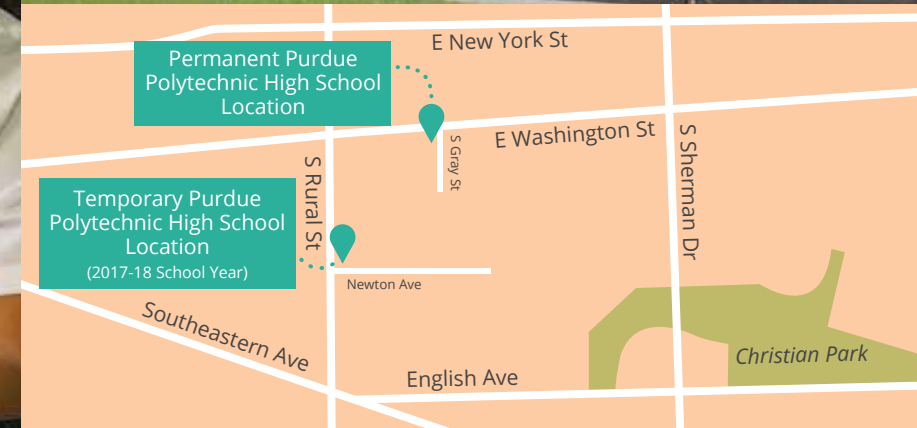
**A typical school day lasts from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. It includes advisory time, hands-on project time, group instruction, and independent work time.**



The permanent home for the Purdue Polytechnic High School will be the historic P.R. Mallory Building at 3029 E. Washington Street in the Englewood neighborhood on the Near Eastside of Indianapolis.

During the school's first year (2017-18), classes will be in a temporary location, 201 S. Rural Street, while the P.R. Mallory Building is renovated.

Both locations are close to public transit, downtown and the high school's corporate partners.

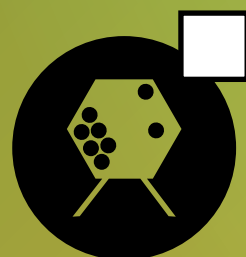
Students who live in the Indianapolis Public Schools district and who complete an application will be given priority status for admission.

*Public Lottery*

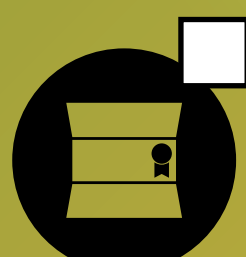
If more applications than spaces available are received before February 3, 2017, a public lottery will be held.

*Who got in?*

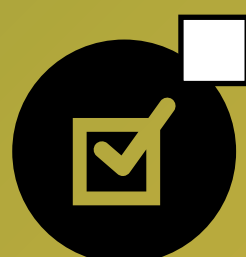
Acceptance letters will be mailed after February 8, 2017, with instructions for enrollment paperwork.
