Students who attend Purdue Polytechnic High School will:

- » spend time each morning in their Personal Learning Community (PLC), setting goals and discussing academic progress with teachers
- » take ownership of learning and set weekly schedules with fewer class periods for a more personalized and in-depth exploration of subjects
- » learn by connecting subjects to real-world challenges and projects
- » focus on science, technology, engineering and math (STEM), especially during first two years
- » connect knowledge and skills to possible careers through internships and industry certifications
- » prepare for a future that includes a college education (such as Purdue University) or a high-tech career.

A typical school day is 9:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.
It includes Personal Learning Community, hands-on project, group instruction and independent work.



The high school's temporary location is in the 525 Union at 525 S. Meridian Street in downtown Indianapolis.

For the 2018-19 school year, the high school plans to be moved into the permanent location, the historic PR Mallory Building at 3029 East Washington Street in the Englewood neighborhood (Near Eastside of Indianapolis).

Both temporary and permanent locations are close to public transit, downtown, and the high school's industry partners.

APPLY TO PURDUE POLYTECHNIC HIGH SCHOOL

November 15, 2017

- » Like most Indianapolis Public Schools (IPS) and charter schools, Purdue Polytechnic High School is participating in Enroll Indy's One Match application process.
- » Apply by visiting pphs.purdue.edu, click apply (you will be redirected to enrollindy.org/apply) and complete the application. Be sure to select **Purdue Polytechnic High School as your #1 choice**.
- » Round 1 for applications will be open from November 15 – January 15. PPHS has 160 slots for students entering the 9th grade in fall 2018.*
- » Priority status for admission is given to students who complete the application, live in the Indianapolis Public Schools district and/or are siblings of current PPHS students.

**The high school is projected to fill all 160 slots during Round 1. However, if slots are available after January 15, then the school will proceed with Round 2 until filled.*



WHO GOT IN?

February 15, 2018

Accepted students will be notified by February 15, 2018, with instructions to complete enrollment paperwork.



DEADLINE TO ENROLL

March 15, 2018

Tell us you are coming! Students will have until March 15 to complete and return enrollment forms for the 2018-19 school year.

Purdue Polytechnic High School Indianapolis is a charter school within the Indianapolis Public Schools (IPS) Innovation Network. This designation allows the school to provide an innovative, personalized learning environment with more independence than a traditional public school. While the school has ties to IPS and Purdue University, it operates independently from both institutions.

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
